Job Title: Treaty 2 Protection Officers - Fisheries Creel Technician (2x)

JOB DESCRIPTION

The incumbent will work under the direction of joint working relations with Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2 and Manitoba Sustainable Development – Fisheries Branch – Dauphin, MB to provide delivery of a creel census on Dauphin Lake, in the Treaty 2 Territory.

DUTIES WILL INCLUDE

- Interviewing anglers on Dauphin Lake and recording catch and economic information;
- Collect a subsample of length, weight and an ageing structure from fish (master anglers only) retained by anglers;
- Data entry of field data will be required.
- Talk to all fishers about lake status – public education.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Good communication skills and experience working/interacting with public.
- Experience in recreational/commercial fishing or fisheries research would be considered an asset.
- Valid Driver's licence – Class 5.
- Experience in data entry with Microsoft Excel would be considered an asset.
- Education in Natural Resource field would be considered an asset.
- Snow mobile and boating experience and operations required.
- Anishinaabe language and understanding of traditions and culture an asset.
