

ANISHINAABE AGOWIDIWINAN TREATY 2 - AUGUST 21, 1871

Resolution 2017-11-09-002

Re: Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 Unity Approach

Whereas; The Council of Chiefs of Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2 and all of the members of Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2, are in full support of working together to protect and implement treaty; and

Whereas; All signatory Nations continue to evolve for the betterment of our Treaty 2 Nation by modernizing our culture, language, elder, youth and women involvement;

Therefore be it resolved: Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2 will work together on behalf of the members of our citizens to advance the collective rights and interests of Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2 in a united, responsible, committed manner for this generation and our future generations;


Therefore be it further resolved; That we renew our mandate to our Senior Officials and Treaty 2 Protection and implementation Office to advance our collective rights with federal and provincial governments regarding any commercial activity in our territory, including any private sector interests, and to seek compensation for the use of our lands, waters and resources;

Therefore be it further resolved; Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2 will be bound by the concept that unity garners strength among our nations and is resolved to develop and advocate for collective economic activities, particularly to benefit collectively from commercial development. Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2 also promotes and supports individual First Nation economic initiatives that benefit their nations.




