

ANISHINAABE AGOWIDIWINAN TREATY 2 - AUGUST 21, 1871

Resolution 2017-11-09-004

Re: Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 Night Hunting Discussion

Whereas, the Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 continue to believe in their sovereignty and will continue to protect and assert its authority over its Territory and;

Whereas, we have a responsibility to protect the land, hunting, trapping, fishing and gathering within our territory and to be stewards and protectors;

Whereas, the Province of Manitoba has expressed its concern over Night Hunting on Treaty 2 Lands through its senior officials and;

Whereas, the Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 will continue to participate through the Land and Water shared management Council process and;

Whereas, the Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 desires to engage the Province of Manitoba regarding Night Hunting and;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 mandates the Land and Water Council to continue discussions within the Laws of Treaty 2 Anishinaabe being cognizant of the Consultation, Accommodation and Prior Consent, as defined by the Supreme Court of Canada.

Therefore be It Further Resolved that the Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 directs the Land and Water Council and Elders Council conduct discussions on Night Hunting with the Province of Manitoba and funded by the province to achieve consensus on best strategies to consult on Night Hunting in order to protect the exercise of Aboriginal and Treaty rights.

Therefore be it Further Resolved that the Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 will enter into an understanding with the Province of Manitoba on Night Hunting and shared management (and enforcement) of natural resources including wildlife within the Treaty 2 territory.
