



# ANISHINAABE AGOWIDIWINAN TREATY 2 - AUGUST 21, 1871

## Resolution 2017-11-09-006

**Re: Prohibiting entry into Treaty 2 prior to Consent**

**Whereas**, Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 is prepared to enter into discussions and negotiations regarding the entry and use of Treaty 2 lands and resources by the Province of Manitoba and;

**Whereas**, the Supreme Court of Canada has issued a decision that includes among other matters, that Indians must be consulted, and prior consent must be secured by other governments prior to any entry of Lands or use of resources and;

**Whereas**, Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan-Treaty 2 continues to assert and exercise its control and authority over Treaty Two Lands;

**Therefore be resolved** that Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan Council of Chiefs will enter negotiations with the Province of Manitoba regarding its Lands and resources and;

**Therefore be it further resolved**, Free entry within our Treaty No 2 Territory is prohibited and that any outside economic development must seek to engage with Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Treaty 2 to arrange for set aside contracts, employment opportunities and other business matters.

**Therefore be it further resolved**, that any costs associated with upgrading of skills for our citizens to prepare for any jobs, will be at the expense of the proponents, the Province of Manitoba and Canada.
