RE: Unfinished Treaty Business and Treaty Implementation

WHEREAS Our Inherent rights, our lands, waters and resources which we had the day before treaty, and did not give up on the day of treaty, we still have on the day after treaty, and still have today.

WHEREAS The purpose of Treaty 2 was only for obtaining the Consent for the sharing of our lands, and for providing compensation for the lands that were taken up for immigration and settlement, and

WHEREAS Compensation was to have been paid by Canada for the lands that were taken up for immigration and settlement, and taking steps to obtaining that compensation is an “unfinished Treaty business” item, and
